Welcome to new site holders, we hope you enjoy the tranquil setting of our Park

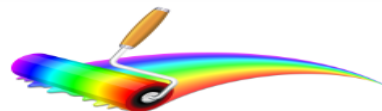
WORKING BEE:

Around the Camp

It is important that **BEFORE** you begin any form of building work or any changes to your site, e.g. re locating a building, building work, fencing, etc.; **you must obtain approval from the Management Committee** (as stated in our Ownership Deed / License to Occupy). If you are unsure it is always best to seek clarity from one of the committee.

Remember no building activity between 20th December and Wellington Anniversary weekend.

Camp reminders

- On arrival at the camp (or as soon as practical), all site holders must let the Camp Managers know how many people will be on your site. Also
- **All visitors must advise the Camp Managers of their arrival and departure;** there is a sign in register in the office of the Camp Managers house. This is an essential Health and Safety requirement.
- Keep your speed down to 5km (walking speed) when driving around the camp – ALL vehicles.
- As always PLEASE CONSERVE WATER

Parking

- If your vehicle(s) doesn't fit completely WITHIN your own site boundaries, park in one of the designated parking areas within the camp at all times (*this is all vehicles including boats and quad bike.*) It is essential in an emergency that services can get through; they require at least a three metre wide clearway.

****Please note the boundary marks on the corner of your properties***

- **Visitors must not bring cars on site, they must park elsewhere.**
- Cars should be off the roadway, there must be room at all times for emergency vehicles to get through all areas.
